What personal data do we collect?

Your e-mail address

Your e-mail address, which you are likely to provide us in case of use of the following services: sending a message via our contact form, creating a price alert, receiving good deals.

Your phone number

Your telephone number, which you are likely to provide us when using the following services: booking a trip, contact support via chat.

Information collected when you contact us

When you send us a message through the contact form, through the chat, by e-mail, we will store your contact information and all information you provide during the exchange, including messages. We will use this data to process your request, and possibly to establish or defend your rights in court.

Your activity on our website

When you use our website, we track your activity and use the data collected anonymously to improve our services. For example, we analyze which features are most frequently used in order to improve them.

How do we use the data we collect?

Good Plans" Service

When you subscribe to our newsletter "Bons Plans", we will send you emails containing good plans. You can unsubscribe at any time using the links at the bottom of each of our emails.

Price Alert Creation" Service

When you sign up for a Price Alert, we will send you emails containing information on the evolution of the ticket price. You can unsubscribe at any time using the links at the bottom of each of our emails.

How long do we keep your personal data?

We will keep your data until it is no longer required for any of these purposes, with a maximum duration of 1 year.

The only exception is the processing of your data for the sending of "Good Plans" and "Price Alert" services. Each e-mail you receive from us will offer you a clear and simple way to unsubscribe and therefore to oppose this type of processing. Consequently, we will continue to use your personal data for this purpose until you unsubscribe.
